

Scholarship Opportunity



A customer's child or grandchild who is a High School Senior may be eligible for a two year or four year college scholarship from Bank of Luxemburg.



BANK OF LUXEMBURG SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Bank of Luxemburg has provided financial services to the area since 1903. In keeping with its tradition of community service and commitment to the education of future civic and business leaders, Bank of Luxemburg has established a Scholarship Opportunity for graduating seniors. Bank of Luxemburg may award annual academic scholarships to the children or grandchildren of Bank of Luxemburg customers. The scholarship is established to assist graduating high school seniors continue his/her education at a university, college, trade, or vocational school. The scholarship will be \$1,000.00 per year for up to four years of full time enrollment per student. This award will be based on positive leadership and character exhibited in school and community activities and work ethic. A scholarship selection committee will administer the application and selection process for the scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA

- Eligible applicants include any high school senior attending High School who is, or whose parent or grandparent is a Bank of Luxemburg customer.
- Applicants must have maintained a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (based on 4.0).
- Applicants must plan to enroll full-time at an accredited two or four year college, university or trade/vocational school in the United States. (Proof of enrollment will be required for release of scholarship payment after the award completion of the first semester.)
- Student employees of Bank of Luxemburg meeting the above requirements will receive the scholarship subject to the bank employee selection process of the scholarship selection committee.
- Gender, race, or financial need will not be criteria for selection.

To continue to receive annual \$1,000.00 scholarship installments, award winners must supply proof of 2.0 or better grade point average, while maintaining full-time student status and proof of continuing enrollment as follows:

- Awards for a two year program must be used within three years from high school graduation date.
- Awards for a four year program must be used within five years from high school graduation date.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applicants must submit a completed application, consisting of five parts: Cover Sheet/Student information, Academic Information, Extracurricular Activities, Community and/or Religious Involvement, and References.

NOTE: Student's name should appear only on the Cover Sheet/Student Information page. Student identification numbers will be assigned by the Scholarship Committee to ensure the scholarship winners are selected based on their merits.

TIMELINE

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| February 1 | Applications will be available at all Bank of Luxemburg locations. |
| March 15 | Deadline for applications. Applications can be dropped off at any Bank of Luxemburg location. |

A committee appointed by Bank of Luxemburg will evaluate the applications. The Committee will announce and make the scholarship awards during the School's Award Program.
